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I Introduction

1.1 Product Feature

Thank you for purchasing the HINGMED upper arm blood pressure monitor. The monitor can be used by multiple users, The blood pressure monitor uses the oscillometric method for blood pressure measurement. It has functions to measure the blood pressure and display the result. When measuring the blood pressure, user needs to wear the cuff on the upper arm.

1.2 Safety Instructions

This instruction manual provides you with important information about the HINGMED upper arm blood pressure monitor. To ensure the safety and proper use of this monitor, read and understand all the instructions carefully. If you do not understand these instructions or have any questions, contact +86 755 23730600 before attempting to use this monitor. For specific information about your own blood pressure, consult with your physician.

1.3 Intended Use

The device is a digital BP monitor intended for using in measuring blood pressure (SYS & DIA) and pulse rate.

Environments of use: Home healthcare environment.

Patient Type: Adults.

1.4 Important Information

Read the important safety Information in this instruction manual before using the monitor. Follow the instructions in the manual thoroughly for your own safety. Keep it for future reference. For specific information about your own blood pressure, consult with your physician.

1.5 Consist of Blood Pressure Monitor

The upper arm blood pressure monitor consists of a BP monitor, cuff, USB wire, App (apply to Q06B).

II Important Safety Information

2.1 Warning

- 2.1.1 Do not service and maintenance while the equipment is in use.
- 2.1.2 Do not modify this equipment without authorization of the manufacturer.

Always consult with your doctor. Self-diagnosis of measurement results and self-treatment are dangerous.

People with severe blood flow problems or blood disorders should consult a doctor before using the device as cuff inflation can cause internal bleeding.

Do not disassemble the device and arm cuff.

* Please do not measure on the arm that is being injected with an intravenous drip or a blood transfusion, otherwise it could cause an accident.

2.2 Caution

- 2.2.1 The patient is the intended operator.
 - * All functions of the medical device can safely be used.
- 2.2.2 Do not use a mobile phone or other devices that emit electromagnetic fields near the medical device. This may result in an incorrect operation of the medical device.
- 2.2.3 If the device was not in service for three months, please recharge the battery after every three months.
 - * If the device was not in service for six months or more, please replace the battery.
- 2.2.4 Please use the adapter which outputs DC 5V 2A to recharge the battery.

When the cuff starts inflating it might be a little uncomfortable.

Do not leave the device unattended with infants or persons who can't express their consent.

Do not apply strong shocks and vibrations or drop the device and arm cuff.

Do not take measurements after bathing, drinking alcohol, smoking, exercising or eating.

Do not wash the arm cuff or immerse it in water.

Do not connect the device with other device, it maybe cause potential damage.

*After Three hundred discharge cycles, the battery needs to be replaced.

Please use the machine in the following environment and storage place, if it is stored or used outside the specified temperature and humidity range (storage conditions: temperature -20 °C $\sim +55$ °C, relative humidity no more than 90%; Operating conditions: Temperature +5 °C $\sim +40$ °C, relative humidity 10% - 95%), the system may not achieve the claimed performance in the specification.

- * Keep it in places where water doesn't splash.
- * Do not keep it in hot, humid, direct sunlight places, places with dust, and places containing salt and sulfur, etc.
- * Keep it in a stable place with no tilt, vibration, impact (including handling), etc.
- * Patients with anticoagulants or blood clotting disorders may get their blood clotted underneath the cuff even if it is worn in the correct position during blood pressure measurements.
- * If the cuff fails to inflate within two and a half minutes, instruct the patient to remove the cuff manually. Prolonged excessive inflation may lead to blood obstruction and make the patient feel uncomfortable.
- * If there is a common arrhythmia, the device fails to meet the claimed performance.
- * Any blood pressure measurement can be influenced by the subject's posture and his/her physical condition.

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- * Moving or speaking during the measurement, inaccurate arm position, machine is not on the level of heart, or the machine shaking causing inaccurate results.
- * For accurate measurements, keep your back straight and sit correctly.
- * Please relax and keep quiet during the measurement.
- * In case of equipment failure, the error code will be displayed in the format of "EC XX", see the section on Common Failures for details.
- * Make sure that the blood pressure measured should be explained by a professional.
- * The product is not intended to be used for newborns.
- * The specifications and labels of this product meet the requirements of EN1060-1 and EN1060-3.
- * Frequent inflating can lead to blood clots and discomfort.
- * Too Frequent measurements may result in poor circulation or bruising.
- * Do not put the cuff over a wound, and it will cause further injury.
- * If there are arterial or venous shunt tubes on the arm, please follow the doctor's instructions before use, otherwise it may cause physical discomfort.
- * People who have had mastectomies may be unwell or have mis-measured results.
- * Do not use other medical and electrical equipment on the blood pressure measuring arm.
- * Please confirm (for example, by observation of the relevant limb) whether the product is available without lasting damage to the patient's blood circulation, suffering from blood circulation disorder. For patients with blood diseases, please use under the guidance of a doctor. Acute internal bleeding may result from compression of the arm during measurement.
- * While in use with a patient, do not service and maintain the device.
- * The device compliance with IEC 60601-1-2, keep it away other HF devices.
- * Please ensure that connect the part's voltage of input or output compliant with IEC60601-1 the requirement of safe extra low voltage, and the part of input or output forbids connecting another device.
- * The manufacturer is responsible for after-sale service, Unauthorized person is not allowed to repair or calibrate the device.
- * The time from switching "ON" until the device is ready for NORMAL USE is less than 10s.

- * When the ambient temperature is 20°C, the time that the device takes to warm up from the minimum storage temperature between uses until the device is ready for its intended use needs one hour.
- * When the ambient temperature is 20°C, the time that the device is to cool from the maximum storage temperature between uses until the device is ready for its intended use needs one hour.
- * After Three hundred discharge cycles, the battery needs to be replaced.
- * Please keep the device away from the children and pets.
- * The list of devices that can potentially cause interference e.g., Microwave oven.
- * Do not use the device to measure Blood Pressure in patients younger than 3 years old.



IV Blood Pressure Measurement

4.1 Wearing the Cuff Correctly


Wear the blood pressure monitor & cuff on the bare left upper arm. Keep the cuff edge 2-3 cm away from the elbow joint, as shown in the picture below.




Friendly reminder: Make sure the cuff fits comfortably around the upper arm and not be too tight or too loose.

4.2 Correct Measuring Posture


Place your left arm on the table, palm upwards, keep the body posture upright and sit quietly. As shown below.





*If the cuff is lower than the heart, place a pellow or towel Pad underneath.





4.3 Measurement of Blood Pressure

In order to obtain accurate measurement results, please obey the following tips before measurement:


- 1. Sit quietly for 5 minutes before measuring.
- 2. Try to measure blood pressure within a fixed time period every day (After getting up or before going to bed).
- 3. Take the measurement within 1 hour after getting up, after going to the toilet, before breakfast, or before taking any medicine.
- 4. Too cold or too hot environment can cause temporary blood pressure fluctuations, please make sure to measure in a comfortable environment.
- 5. Please do not eat, smoke, drink, exercise, take a bath or do any type of activity before measurement.
- 6. If the same person measures again, the arm should be rested for at least 2 to 3 minutes. After the arm has fully recovered blood circulation, take the measurement again.

Measurement Method

- 1. Press [Start/Stop] to measure directly.
- 2. Click "Start Measurement" on the APP Home page to measure blood pressure.

(*For APP operation, please refer to "APP Quick User Guide".)

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Measurement by the App (Apply to Q06B)

- (1) Login to the APP, press the "Start" button on the "Home" page, the cuff start to inflate automatically, and number will increase on the device display and the APP. Remain still and do not move your arm and until the measurement process is complete.
- (2) When the measurement is complete, your cuff completely deflates, and your blood pressure & pulse rate will be displayed and broadcasted on the device and shown on the APP.

Notice: To stop the inflation or measurement push the Start/Stop button, the monitor will stop inflating, start deflating and will turn off.

4.4 Measurement Process

During the measuring process, the cuff is inflated automatically, and the device starts measuring.

After the measurement is completed, the air exhaust valve releases the air automatically.

4.5 Check Measurement History

- (1) Press the "<>" button on the side of the device to check the history directly on the device.
- (2) You can also view History through APP.

5.1 Download the APP

Please download the APP from the Google Play Store for Android or from Apple App Store For iOS.

(*For APP operation, please refer to "APP Quick User Guide".)

5.2 Platform

1. Hardware requirement: Mobile phone with Bluetooth function.

Display devices must have a minimum resolution of 480x800.

2. Software requirement:

Apple mobile phone: Apple iOS9.0 version or above.


Android phone: Android 6.0 version and above.

VI Error Message

When an error occurs, the screen will display the following error code:

Error code	Cause	Solution
EC01	Cuff not applied correctly.	Take the cuff off, read "Blood pressure measurement" carefully. Wait 2-3minutes. Take another measurement.
EC04		Make sure that the cuff is worn correctly, and the arm circumference is within the measured range.

^{*}Security measures: when logging out the account the data will be completely erased, user needs to register a new account.

VII Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

- **1** Q: During measurement, I reluctantly get nervous and hold my breath. Does this affect the measurement result?
 - A: Yes. It will affect the measurement result! Holding your breath may raise your blood pressure, please keep calm when measuring, don't get nervous, don't talk or don't do any activity, try to sit quietly and relax for 5-15 minutes before measuring.
- **Q**: When measuring, the blood pressure value is sometimes high and sometimes low, why is this happening?
 - A: Research shows that human blood pressure is constantly fluctuating throughout the day. blood pressure stays low during sleep, blood pressure stays high from 8:00 am to 10:00 am,
 - The value measured by the digital BP monitor reflects the blood pressure at the moment of measurement. Please measure 2/3 times and compare the value. Also, it is recommended to measure blood pressure at the same time every day, with the same posture.
- **3** Q: Repeated, continuous and rapid measurement for many times, the results are all different, is it okay?
 - A: Repeated and continuous measurement will make the arm oppressed and lead to poor blood circulation, which can cause changes in blood pressure result. It is recommended to rest for 5-15 minutes before taking the second measurement.
- **4** Q: Why is the result of the home measurement result lower than the result of the hospital?
 - A: Changes in the environment can cause fluctuations in the human body & emotions to some extent. Emotional stability and a suitable environment are generally better while measured at home than measured at a hospital. The value is 20-30mmHg lower, and you will understand the average blood pressure when you are calm at home.
- **6** Q: Where is the On/Off button of this blood pressure monitor?
 - A: Press and hold the measurement button for 5 seconds to shut down. When not in use for a long time, it is recommended to turn off the device to save battery power.
- **6** Q: How to adjust the volume?
 - A: Press the up and down keys on the side of the monitor once while the screen is on, press the ">" button on the machine for 5 seconds. When "U" appears on the screen, you can press the up and down keys to adjust the volume. When it is adjusted to "U00", it means the device is in mute.
- **?** Q: When measuring, the machine buzzes, and sometimes it gradually deflates, making a beeping sound, what's the matter?

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- A: When measuring with a BP monitor, the cuff pressure rises during cuff pressurization. There will be a buzzing sound when measuring the boost voltage. If the user does not cooperate, there may be an error occur. After the operation reminder, the pressure will decrease, and the device will automatically switch to reduce voltage measurement to ensure successful measurement, at which point there will be 3 "beeps"; voltage boost & voltage reduction, it is self-checking and self-switching, no need for manual switching.
- * If the error cannot be corrected and you need assistance, please call the dealer or HINGMED after-sales service department.

VIII Maintenance

8.1 Maintenance Inspection & Safety Management

Visually inspect the blood pressure monitor casing for any cracks or damage, check whether the pressure gauge is tightly connected to the cuff. If the blood pressure monitor is damaged in any way it is FORBIDDEN TO USE. Please contact the HINGMED after-sales service department.

8.2 Equipment Cleaning & Disinfection

Blood pressure monitor and accessories do not need to be sterilized but must be kept clean. If there is any contamination, it should be cleaned first and then disinfected in time. In order to avoid causes of long-term damage to the product, it is recommended to follow hospital regulations take necessary steps to sterilize the product.

- * After use by infected people or suspected infected people, please disinfect the affected parts of the product.
- * When cleaning and disinfecting, do not soak the product and accessories in any type of liquid. Do not let liquid flow into the charging port or the case of the blood pressure monitor to prevent any damage to the blood pressure monitor.

Cleaning

- 1. Turn off the main device before cleaning the BP monitor.
- 2. Wash a soft, clean, lint-free cloth with mild soapy water or immersion in aggressive, diluted cleaning agents.
- 3. Wipe down instrument and patient contact surfaces.
- 4. Wipe with a clean, dry soft cloth.

Disinfection

- 1. It is recommended that users soak in about 75% medical ethanol disinfectant
- 2. Use clean & dry gauze, and then wipe the surface of the object to be disinfected with gauze
- 3. Clean surface for 2 times and do it for 3 minutes.
- 4. Be careful not to immerse the unit or the cuff in liquid
- 5. In the belt, it can be air-dried or disinfected with a clean, dry cloth.
- 6. Wipe it with a dry cloth.

^{**}Note: Clean before disinfection, ethanol is flammable, please keep away from the fire source, and those who are allergic to alcohol should use ethanol disinfectant with caution. Cleaning the device by every month is recommended.

IX Calibration

The accuracy of this blood pressure monitor has been carefully tested and is designed for a long service life. It is generally recommended to have the device inspected every two years to ensure correct functioning and accuracy. Please consult your local authorized distributor or dealer.

X Replace Battery

- -Remove the setting screw as shown on the picture.
- Use the new battery to replace the old battery.
- -Place the positive electrode of the lithium battery in the battery slot consistent with the positive electrode of the shell material display.

Disposal of this product and used batteries should be carried out in accordance with the national regulations for the disposal of electronic products.
